Points of Consideration in Pursuing the HDFS Major:

- Students are only allowed 2 attempts in 2 of the 4 courses to achieve the required final grade of a **B minus**. **If the B minus is not made in 3 or more of the courses in the 1st attempt or the B minus is not made in the 2nd attempt, then the student cannot continue in the major.**
- Registration for major classes will be allowed AFTER final grades are posted and transcripts reflect that all prerequisite courses have been completed satisfactorily with a minimum grade of B minus.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION (See General Bulletin for more details)

1. Liberal Studies completed with a 2.0 GPA; completion of State Core Requirements & University Requirements.
2. A Minimum of 120 unduplicated credit hours (only 2 credit hours of which may be in physical activity courses).
3. A minimum of 45 credit hours of 3000-4000 level courses, 30 of which must be taken at FSU.
4. Nine credits in summer (only for students enrolling in FSU with less than 60 credit hours)
5. Last 30 credit hours and half of major course hours at FSU.
6. Completion of major course requirements; a grade of B- or higher in each required pre-requisites, a grade of C- or higher in all other required major courses (unless otherwise noted).
7. A University Academic Progress Check with Registrar's Office (University Center A3900).
8. A College of Human Science Academic Progress Check with your assigned academic advisor.
