

Scholarly Engagement Policy Face to Face Doctoral Students (Ed.D. or Ph.D.) Updated January 2019

The goal of the Scholarly Engagement requirement is to prepare doctoral graduates who can acquire, evaluate, communicate, and extend knowledge through active participation in the scholarly community.

Annual Confirmation of Scholarly Engagement: Each year, as part of the annual review process, doctoral students must demonstrate to their faculty advisor's satisfaction either 1) completion of any benchmark activity *or* 2) concrete progress toward the completion of any benchmark activity.

Prerequisites to be completed *before* **key milestones in doctoral progression**: Certain benchmarks *must be completed before* students are allowed to 1) take the preliminary exam, 2) defend a proposal/prospectus, and 3) register for graduation.

Prerequisites to be completed before key milestones in doctoral progression: Certain benchmarks *must be completed before* students are allowed to 1) take the preliminary exam, 2) defend a prospectus, and 3) register for graduation.

BENCHMARKS FOR SCHOLARLY ENGAGEMENT

Before Preliminary Exam

- Develop a resumé
- Complete the CITI human subjects training (to be completed in EDF6486)
- And at least one of the following:
 - o Attend a professional development conference/meeting or
 - o Attend/watch at least 2 Relevant Research Roundtable (R3) presentations

Before Prospectus Defense

- Updated resumé
- And at least one of the following:
 - o Attend at least 1 state, regional, or national conference (professional or research association)
 - o Attend/watch an FSU professional development seminar/workshop

Before Graduation

- Updated resumé
- And at least one of the following:
 - Present at a national, state, regional, or local conference/professional development seminar or
 - o Submit an article to a professional organization newsletter and/or journal.
