Dr. Morrison has served as consulting editor of *The Review of Educational Research, The American Educational Research Journal,* and the *ASHE-ERIC Research Report Series*. He is the founding editor of three peer-reviewed publications: *On the Horizon, The Technology Source*, and *Innovate*. He is author and co-author of nine books and over 200 journal articles focusing on educational planning and on using information technology tools in educational organizations. He has presented over 240 conference presentations and workshops around the world.
