In addition, he studied German at the University of Heidelberg and German and sociology at the University of Munich. He currently is professor emeritus of education at UNC-Chapel Hill. He served as vice president (Division J) of the American Educational Research Association and received the Distinguished Scholar Award from AERA's Special Interest Group on Strategic Change. He served as consulting editor of *The Review of Educational Research, The American Educational Research Journal*, and the *ASHE-ERIC Research Report Series* and as founding editor of three peer-reviewed

publications: On the Horizon, The Technology Source, and Innovate. He is author and co-author of nine books and over 200 journal articles focusing on educational planning and on using information technology tools in educational organizations. He has made over 240 conference presentations and workshops around the world.
